III. General Information on Data Processing

1. Purpose and Scope of the processing of personal data

We only process the personal data of our users to the extent necessary to provide a functional feedback mechanism and to report digital barriers.

When you contact us by email or via a contact form, the data you provide (your email address and, if applicable, your name) will be stored by us in order to answer your questions. The provision of further information is voluntary and merely makes it easier for us to contact you to answer your enquiry. We delete the data collected in this context once the purpose no longer applies.

The processing of personal data of our users takes place regularly only with the consent of the user.

2. Legal Basis for the Processing of Personal Data

Article 6(1)(a) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) serves as the legal basis for obtaining the consent of the data subject for the processing of personal data.

3. Revocation of consent to data processing

You have the right to withdraw your consent to data processing at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

4. Deletion of Data and Duration of Storage

The personal data of the data subject will be deleted or blocked as soon as the purpose of storage no longer applies and the request has been clarified.

5. Recipients of Personal Data

The recipients of personal data are exclusively authorized bodies within the university that require this data to fulfil the stated purposes. This may include IT support, for example, if it has access to the data as part of its duties. In certain cases, external service providers, such as hosting providers or maintenance companies, may also be granted access if they are contractually obliged to maintain confidentiality.

6. Rights of the Data Subject

1) If your personal data is processed, then you as a data subject have the following rights against the Controller as established in the GDPR:

- Right of Information,
- Right to Rectification or Erasure,
- Right to Restriction of Processing,
- Right to Object to Processing,
- Right to Data Portability.

(2) You also have the right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by us.
